Once again summer flew by. It was nice to have some rain in the first part of July which certainly helped with the fire situation and our newly planted seedlings.

This summer conducted a salvage operation on Mt. Law, removing most of the dead burned trees (except for the largest) and retaining those that were still alive and with an intact root system. The intent behind leaving these trees was to provide some structure and biodiversity values on what was a very catastrophic fire summer and provide some shade for the seedlings we

plan on planting there next spring.

started our We also landscape level wildfire treatments. mitigation This is a very long-term project where we will be removing surface ladder fuels to create fuel management corridors across the Community These corridors Forest. will slow the rate of spread wildfires, allowing crews to fight these fires on the ground, and also open up opportunities to re-introduce cultural burning practices across the areas we manage.

Recently, we started harvesting seven small blocks near Silver Lake behind Peachland. In each of these blocks we are leaving approximately 25 of the largest mature trees per hectare and patches of immature trees. The larger trees will provide habitat values for birds and other wildlife and seeds to help regenerate a new forest.

Finally Ntityix Resources is the proud recipient of the **Forest Products** Association of Canada (FPAC)/ Canadian Council Aboriginal Business (CCAB) Indigenous **Business** Leadership Award for 2022. This award recognizes selected Indigenous entrepreneurs for their success in a forest products business. were nominated by Tolko.

WIBCO Construction successfully completed a 3000sf office tenant improvement project for the BC First Nations Council. The **Justice** project included an open concept office space with and drywall glass partitions throughout. The project was completed one week in advance of the contractual date to allow the owner time to receive and set up their new office furniture. This is the second project with BC FNJC, and we look forward to working with them again in the future.

WIBCO also completed some tenant improvements for the Peachland RV this Summer. Although the scope of work was small this has given us the opportunity to build a relationship with the client

for future larger scale projects.

WIBCO is in the Vernon area along Westside Road and are in the process of construction a new custom home for a family who lost their home during the White Rock Lake wildfire in 2021. The home will be a 1300sf bungalow with a crawl space and have two bedrooms, an ensuite, and open concept kitchen / living room. We are currently framing the floor to this home and expect to have the house at lock up stage by early October. We are pushing completion of this home to have the customer in their new home, prior to the Christmas Holidays. Please follow us on Facebook for regular progress updates and photos.

We are also in the process of securing our Building Permit for a custom home in Glenrosa. This customer also lost their home during last years wildfires in the upper Glenrosa neighbourhood. The new home will be a bungalow walkout.

WIBCO has been busy preparing budgets and are in the early stages of planning for a handful of projects, set to start late Fall or early Spring 2023.
